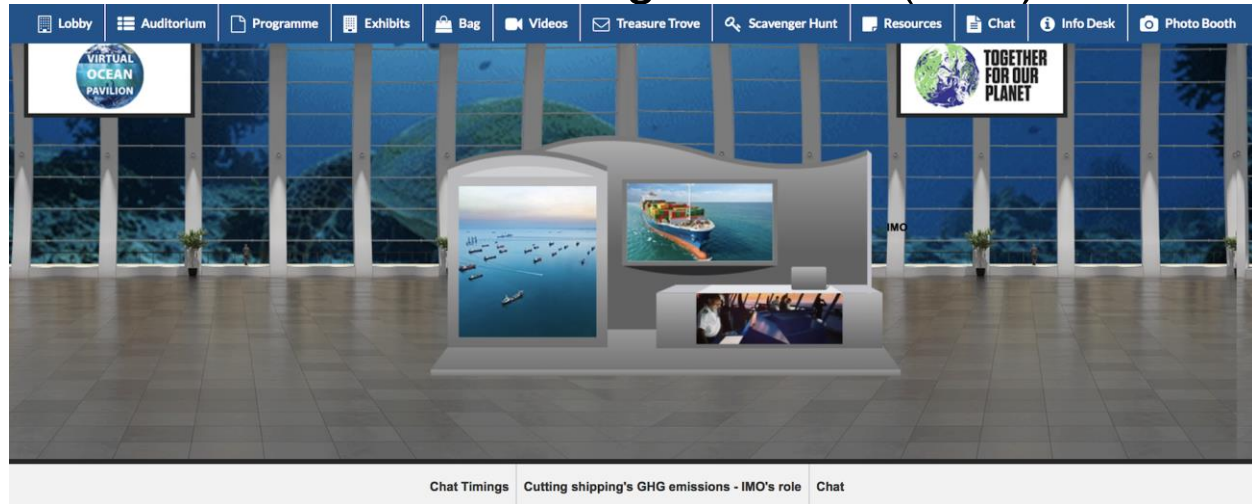


# COP26 VIRTUAL OCEAN PAVILION EXHIBITS
